It is basically a simple unbolt and bolt up process. You will need to remove the stock left side foot peg bracket from the bike. Now you will match the shifter bracket up to the stock foot peg bracket align the foot peg bracket holes up with the air shifter bracket holes. Now reinstall the bracket on the bike frame using the stock bolts you removed and tighten them to oem specs. Next you will want to mount your air shifter cylinder on the bracket, to do so install your cylinder with the hole in the end over the threaded stud and use install the nylon insert lock nut and tighten the nut making sure that you STILL HAVE A SMALL AMOUNT OF PLAY with the cylinder. You DO NOT want the cylinder to be bolted solid with the bracket. Now you are ready to install the shift shaft actuator. Install the unit on the shift rod loosely, make sure the bolt heads are facing towards you—next attach your cylinder shaft and measure the distance between the end of the collet (the nut on the shaft) and the end of the cylinder where the shaft starts to go in the cylinder. this measurement needs to be 7/8 to 1 inch of shaft travel. You are now done, attach your air line and go have fun.
